More than ever, philanthropy – the love of humankind – was a priority at the Topeka Community Foundation as we continued working to be the best foundation possible for our community. As we look back on 2020, we are proud of our community's resiliency and the progress of our organization.

- **Financial Strength:** With contributions totaling \$5.2 million and an investment return of 8.75%, the Foundation currently has more than \$83 million under management.
- **Community Impact:** In direct response to community need as a result of COVID-19, the Foundation awarded 55 grants totaling \$118,202.
- **Donor Services:** Nine new funds were established at the Foundation in 2020 – each with its own charitable purpose. It's a privilege to work with donors to ensure stewardship over these funds.
